



Guarantee

TERMS OF GUARANTEE. Pye Ltd., guarantee to replace or repair within twelve months from date of installation, any component in the Pye receiver covered by this guarantee, which, in the opinion of the Company, is faulty or below standard through inferior construction or material. Components expressly excluded from this guarantee are valves, cathode ray tubes, transistors and batteries. Failure to observe the undernoted conditions renders the guarantee null and void.

CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE

1. The receiver must have been purchased at the full list price from a Pye Service Agent, or in the case of a hire purchase agreement, the instalments must have been paid as they fell due.
2. Pye Ltd., do not accept liability for any faults arising in their receivers caused by accident, mis-use, neglect, tampering with or unauthorised modification of the receiver, or any attempt at internal adjustment or repair by any person other than an accredited Pye Service Agent.
3. Pye Ltd., do not accept liability for any consequential loss or injury arising from any of their products.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Valves are guaranteed by their manufacturers for a period of three months from date of purchase and cathode ray tubes for a period of twelve months.

Claims under this guarantee should, in the first case, be made to the Pye Service Agent from whom you purchased the receiver. The Agent is entitled to make a charge for labour and collection and delivery of the receiver to or from your house.

Should the Agent decide to return the receiver to us at Cambridge, or the nearest Service Depot, the guarantee covers replacement of parts only. A charge will be made to cover the cost of handling, labour, packing and carriage. No responsibility can be taken for damage in transit.

If an estimate of the cost is required before repairs are commenced, this should be made quite clear when the Agent returns the receiver to the Service Depot.

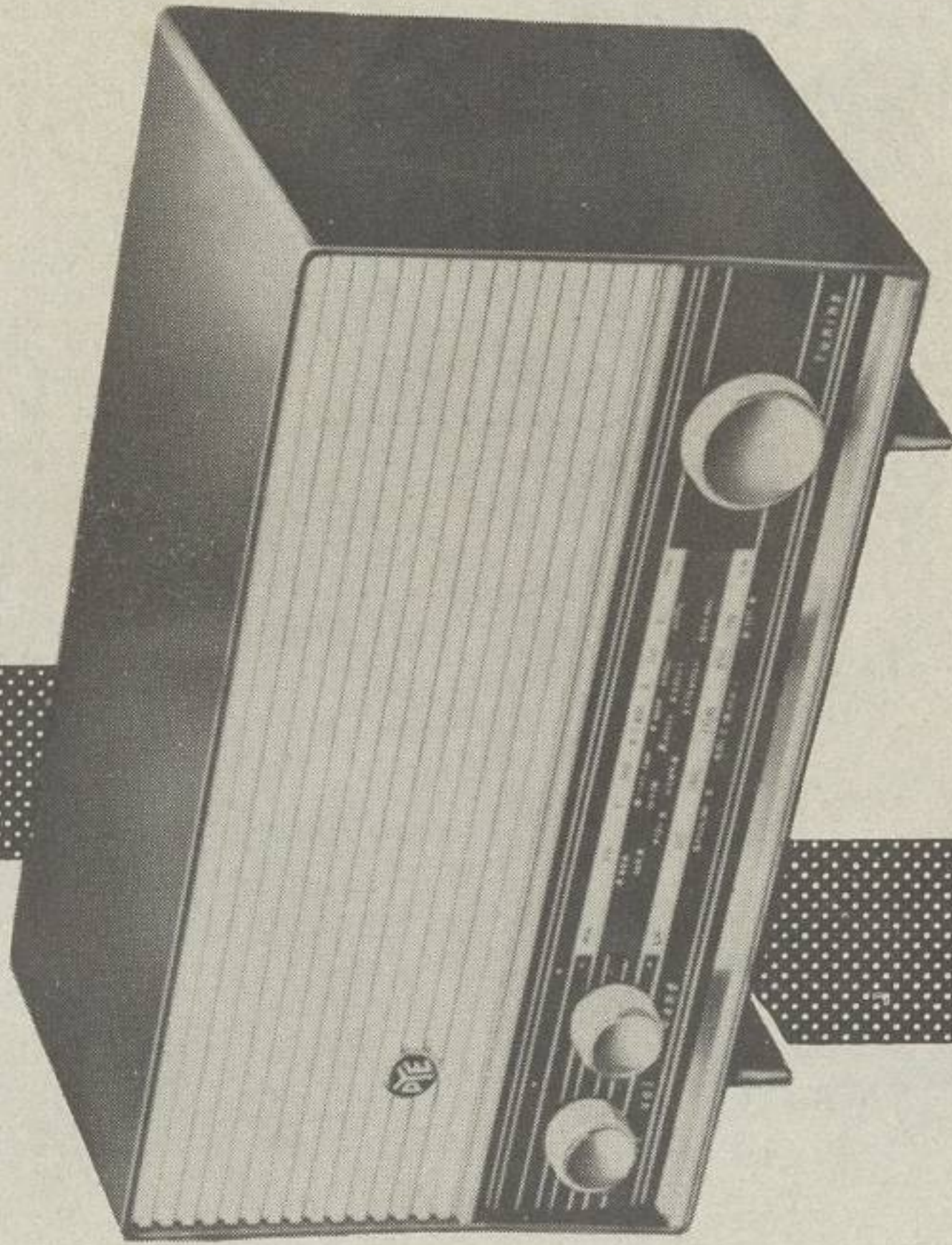
A detailed description of the symptoms noted is of considerable help in ensuring that the receiver is serviced satisfactorily. All correspondence must quote the Serial Number of the receiver. All receivers returned for service must be sent carriage paid.

This guarantee is not valid unless the Record Card is completed and returned to Pye Ltd., Cambridge, within seven days of the date of purchase of the receiver.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR
INSTALLING AND
OPERATING

IMPORTANT

The receiver must always be completely disconnected from the mains before removing the back.

To prevent overheating, a space of at least 4 inches should be left at the back of the receiver.

POWER SUPPLY

195 - 250 volts a. c. mains.

INSTALLATION

When leaving the factory, the set is adjusted for operation from 221 - 250 volt mains.

1. Should your mains voltage be between 195 - 220 volts, remove the back of the receiver and adjust the voltage selector plug to the alternative position, as indicated by the figures printed on the back.
2. Remove the back, bring the mains lead out through the hole near the bottom right-hand corner, ensuring that excessive slack is not left inside the set. Replace the back and tighten up the four retaining screws.
3. The receiver contains an internal ferrite rod aerial, and no earth connection is necessary.

Medium Wave	182 - 570 metres

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Switch on by turning the off-vol. control in a clockwise direction.
2. Select the required waveband by turning the band control so that the pip on the knob is opposite the appropriate spot on the tuning scale.
3. Rotate the tuning control until the pointer behind the tuning scale coincides with the name or wavelength of the required station. Readjust as necessary for the loudest signal with minimum background noise.
4. Adjust the volume to the required level.
5. To switch off, turn the off-vol. control anti-clockwise until the switch is heard to operate.

SERVICE

If at any time your receiver fails to operate satisfactorily please contact the Pye Agent from whom it was obtained, or should you have moved, your nearest Pye Agent.

THE PYE GUARANTEE

This receiver is covered by the Pye Guarantee provided that the record card is completed and returned to Pye Ltd. Cambridge within seven days of the purchase date.
