

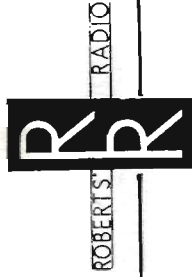

## General Instructions

### THE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

**T** Rotate the left-hand control knob—WAVE-BAND SELECTOR—clockwise from the OFF position so that the indicator spot on the control knob coincides with the waveband desired—M for Medium Waves, L for Long Waves.

Selection of stations is effected by rotating the centre control knob—TUNING—until the pointer coincides with the desired station indication, and finally setting the right-hand knob—VOLUME—for the required level of sound.

Wavelength markings are provided on Medium Waves to assist in the selection of additional stations not marked by name.

Because of the directional properties of a receiver employing a rod-aerial it will usually be found necessary to rotate the set to the direction from which the clearest reception is obtained.

### VALVES

The following Mullard valves are used in this receiver :—

DK96    DF96    DAF96    DL96

It is recommended that only these types be purchased should replacement become necessary.

### BATTERIES

The batteries recommended for use with this receiver are :—

H.T. Ever-Ready Batrymax "B126"

L.T. Ever-Ready "AD4"

When disconnecting the batteries for replacement, care must be taken in withdrawing the plugs from them to avoid fracturing the battery leads.

## GUARANTEE

**I**N substitution for any statutory or other warranty or condition express or implied, the Company guarantees this Receiver against failure arising through faulty workmanship or material for a period of 12 calendar months from date of purchase for cash or on deferred payment terms or date of hire purchase agreement. During this period, subject to the conditions hereunder, the Company will replace or repair any defective part free of charge if the receiver is returned to the Works or to any authorised Service Depot of the Company.

### CONDITIONS

1. THE Guarantee only becomes effective if the Guarantee register card is duly completed and received by the Company within 7 days of date of purchase or of hire purchase agreement. It is applicable only to the original purchaser who has purchased for cash or on deferred payment terms or hire purchase from a recognised radio retailer at the Company's published retail selling price and if on hire purchase the instalments are not in arrears. Any claim must give particulars of the serial number and type.
2. THE Guarantee does not cover (a) valves, batteries or accumulators, (b) damage resulting from incorrect use other than in accordance with the operating instructions issued by the Company, (c) consequential damage, (d) the labour charges incurred in the stripping down and reassembling of the receiver.
3. THE Guarantee will be rendered invalid if the receiver is misused or if any unauthorised alteration, modification or substitution of any part or parts of it be made or if the serial number be defaced or altered.
4. THE return to the Company of the receiver or any part should it be necessary must be carriage paid to destination, the Company accepting no responsibility for damage in transit.
5. IF the receiver or any part is returned for any cause not covered by this Guarantee (see note below) all costs involved including a charge for inspection, handling and labour charges must be paid.
6. If any service under this Guarantee is given by the Company at the users home a charge will be made for expenses in addition to labour charges.
7. NO dealer has any authority to vary the terms of this Guarantee.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

You are advised when making a claim under the Guarantee to do so through your Wireless Dealer. Any reliable dealer should be able to locate the trouble and often apply a quick remedy. He will also be able to advise you if the fault is attributable to some part of the installation or to some simple matter not covered by the Guarantee and not in the receiver itself. The Dealer is entitled to charge for services rendered in implementing the Guarantee.
